

GENERAL RULES

All play will be governed by the National Federation of the State High School League Rules with the following modifications:

- 1) M.S.F. Co-Rec rules apply.
- 2) All matches are RALLY SCORING, 2 out of 3 games to 25 points, 27 point cap. Time limit is 50 minutes.
If the time runs out before the second game is finished, the first team to achieve a 2 point advantage will win the game.
If a 3rd game is needed, it will be played to 15 points, with a 17 point cap. The match time will be extended to 55 minutes.
- 3) A minimum of 5 minutes will be given for warm ups.
- 4) A player cannot play on more than one team.
- 5) The rosters are due on _____.
- 6) Please review the schedule for Refing. You may need to ref the game before or after the one you are scheduled to play.
A minimum of 2 people are needed for Refing.
*****Any team that does not supply at least 2 people for refing will forfeit their participation in the Playoffs at the end of the regular season.**
- 7) The Refing Team is required to:
--Keep track of the score for the match
--Enforce the 50 minute time limit
- 8) When you are scheduled to Ref – We ask that you be on the court 10 minutes before the first match.
- 9) Each team shall supply a game ball. The captains shall then decide on the ball to be used during the match. If the captains cannot agree, the Ref will decide.
- 10) The nets will be up 15 minutes before the first matches. This will allow the teams enough time to complete their warm ups before the game time.
- 11) It will be a forfeit of the first game if a team is not ready to play at 5 minutes after their starting time. It will be a forfeit of the second game if a team is not ready to play by 10 minutes after their starting time.
- 12) No unattended children in the gym.

SEE THE BACK SIDE FOR ADDITIONAL RULES-

13) If due to inclement weather, District #742 schools are closed or close early, there will be no Volleyball that night. The school closings will be announced on WJON and KCLD radio stations.

14) Teams will consist of three men and three women.

At no time shall the number of men in the game exceed that number of women.

Note: If a team starts or is reduced to five players, it is permissible to play with three women and two men. (Four women and two men is not allowed). If a team starts or is reduced to four players, two shall be men and two women.

If there are only four players on the team, two are considered front row and two back row. The open positions shall always be considered as the center front and the center back.

15) In the Upper Gym:

- If a ball hits the curtain between the two courts, it is a deal ball.
- A player may step into the adjacent court only **after** they have played the ball.
- Regarding the back line on the south end of the courts, a player **cannot** step on or into the court while serving.
